



TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR APPROVAL AND OPERATION OF A FOOD VENDOR

1. By signing this form you and your organisation / company / business ("the Food Vendor") shall be deemed to have agreed to and shall abide by the rules and regulations stipulated by the Organisers and the conditions herein.
2. Each Food Vendor shall deal with all participants and the general public at the Event with politeness and respect and is not to be embroiled in argument or behaviour likely to disrupt any activity at the Event or bring the Event into disrepute.
3. Each Food Vendor shall observe all relevant health and safety requirements and food and hygiene requirements and the by-laws of Thames Coromandel District Council.
4. A site shall comprise of an area as laid out by the organisers and as agreed in confirmed booking; each Food Vendor shall be responsible to provide his/her own necessities to operate from there; shelter, tables etc. If power is required, please indicate this in the registration form. An additional charge will apply.
5. Each Food Vendor shall contain their stall within the perimeter of the site and shall not allow items or equipment to extend outside of the site's perimeter. Each Food Vendor shall keep the stall clean, tidy and hygienic at all times and shall remove all rubbish off site at the close of the Event.
6. The location of your site shall be determined by the Organisers at their sole discretion. Generally all Food Vendor will be positioned together.
7. All Food Vendor vehicles other than food trucks will be allocated a parking space outside the immediate festival area.
8. Camping is permitted the night before the event on festival grounds. If you are camping the night prior you will have access to camping between 4 - 6pm on Wednesday 29th December 2021. If you are arriving on the day of the festival the site will be open to Food Vendors at 7.00am on 30th December 2021. Each Food Vendor will be directed onto the allocated site. The festival is open to the public from 10am. Food Vendors must vacate the Event site no later than 6.00pm on the day of the festival. Please restrict vehicle speed on site to 5km maximum.
9. Applications will be considered on the first come first serve basis, however consideration will be applied to ensure a broad range of stalls are available. The Applicant must specify all goods being sold. The Food Vendor agrees only to sell the product described in this application.
10. No subletting or sharing of sites is permitted.

11. The Organisers have the sole discretion whether to accept your application and they are under no obligation to give any reason for their refusal. The organisers' decision shall be final.

12. No refund shall be made to any Food Vendor for failure to utilise the located site or for its poor performance whether caused by bad weather or lack of crowd participation or for any other reason whatsoever including cancellation of the event due to extreme weather conditions.

13. Under no circumstances shall the Organisers make good or accept responsibility or liability:

(i) for any damage or theft or loss of any property, goods, articles, or things whatsoever and whosoever placed, deposited, brought into or left upon any part of the Event venue by the Food Vendor or by anyone on his/her behalf,

(ii) for any personal injury howsoever caused or contributed at the Event;

(iii) for any financial loss suffered by a Food Vendor as a result of his/her participation in the Event or due to the cancellation of the Event or due to poor crowd participation at the Event,

And every Food Vendor shall indemnify and hold the Organisers, their members/officials, volunteers and agents harmless in respect thereof and for all costs and expenses arising by reason of it.

14. Food Vendors are encouraged to use biodegradable plates and cutlery if possible.
